Song of America aired on over 300 radio stations in the United States, and, according to data gathered by the WFMT Radio Network, reached a cumulative number of 5.3 million listeners in the United States. It was also made available by the European Broadcasting Union to its 48 member stations in 2012, reaching another 3.1 million listeners abroad.

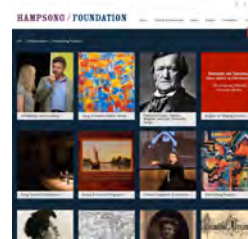

The series views classic song as the prism of a particular time, refracting and illuminating currents in politics, society, artistic creation, and intellectual thought.

Song: Mirror of the World presents and explores classic song, defined as poetry set to music, as a global identifier of the culture from which it came. The series takes a broad, humanities-based approach to the role of song in society and its relationship to cultural movements, historical events, and the human experience, with a special focus on cross-cultural dialogues throughout the European continent, and between Europe and the United States.

WITH YOUR HELP, *Song: Mirror of the World* will begin airing on WFMT Chicago in Oct. 2014!

Through private donors, we have raised funding for the first half of the costs, and we need your help with the second half. The total cost of the 13-program series ***Song: Mirror of the World*** is \$86,738, and we still need to raise half of that amount \$43,369.
